


# EMPOWERING CHANGE-MAKERS Holistic Learning and Leadership for Sustainable Development

## SUMMARY

This September, we worked alongside the African Rural University (ARU) and the Uganda Rural Development Institute (URDT) to bring impactful teaching and leadership programmes to staff and students.

At ARU, Dr. Naveen Hyder and Nicole Zulu engaged approximately 65 students in a holistic learning experience centered on becoming changemakers. They explored how students can lead "above the surface" by cultivating strong value systems and "below the surface" through environmental stewardship. The professors' innovative integration of their courses was truly remarkable.

At URDT, Cindy Au and Dr. Karen Panzarella worked with 20 educators to enhance their teaching methods, introducing tools like Kahoot, Moodle, and Zoom. The educators appreciated how the courses were tailored to fit their unique teaching environments.

The enthusiasm of the participants and the support from the Kagadi community made this programme especially enriching and memorable.
