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SUMMARY

In mid-October, Professors Without Borders and Ecolotrip collaborated to deliver an interactive four-day Climathon event, designed to inspire and equip the next generation of Francophone African environmental activists and green entrepreneurs with high-impact skills.

The programme commenced with an online introductory series on green entrepreneurship from 11–12 October, setting the stage for an intensive in-person session from 18–19 October. Throughout these sessions, participants engaged in immersive workshops on climate-driven business, innovative design thinking, and transformative social entrepreneurship. Nadine Minampala led these workshops and built participants' capacities to overcome challenges and drive sustainable impact through green business ventures.

To finish off the programme, participants presented their project ideas in a pitch competition, receiving invaluable feedback from a panel of four industry experts. This experience not only honed participants' pitching skills but also encouraged them to learn from one another, build solutions together, and connect with social investors and potential collaborators.




This programme allowed us to build self-confidence, gain experience, and see new things. It showed us that we can go beyond our limits and always innovate.
