SUMMARY

In April 2025, Professors Without Borders, in partnership with Ecolotrip, delivered a dynamic two-day programme in Dakar, Senegal, as part of Ecolotrip's "Climathon Series." This initiative brought together 50 young students and aspiring entrepreneurs to explore how climate challenges can be turned into business opportunities.

Led by climate entrepreneurship expert Nadine Minampala, the hybrid programme combined online learning with an in-person hackathon. Students were introduced to the fundamentals of areen entrepreneurship and design thinking, equipping them with tools to ideate, prototype, and pitch sustainable business solutions. Emphasis was placed on leveraging local resources, circular economy models, and usercentered innovation.

The programme culminated in the presentation of eight project pitches, with three standout ideas selected for their relevance, feasibility, and impact. Participants gained valuable skills in business modeling, pitching, and collaborative problem-solving, all within the context of climate resilience and community empowerment.

By nurturing climate-focused entrepreneurship, this programme equipped the participants with the ability to troubleshoot challenges in their ventures, fostering a new generation of changemakers ready to drive sustainable transformation from the ground up.
