SUMMARY

Professors Without Borders was delighted to deliver its Empowering Digital Transformation - Leadership, Innovation and Sustainability programme to 142 faculty members/staff, and students at the Ekiti State University, in Nigeria, from 28th of July to 1st of August 2025.

The week included five day-long workshops for faculty, staff, and students on Social Entrepreneurship, Finance for Africa, Research Methods, and Al Tools & Career Discovery.

The professors then ran multiple 40-45 minutes long workshops with the students across 3 classes, Bob Eckhart teaching about how they can use design thinking in solving social problems, Charlie Dove-Edwin teaching students about governance and finance, Oluseyi Sodiya teaching them on how to discover themselves (mastery of effective communication, critical thinking, creativity, and collaboration skills to potential employers), and using Al tools to work smarter, and Brieanne showing them how to use research methods to solve daily challenges and school projects.

EKSU was delighted with the insightful topics and engaging facilitation. For faculty & staff, the topics on blended teaching/learning and AI tools were timely as they embark on curricular reviews, meaning that they could implement their learning almost immediately. There was never a dull moment in the classrooms, which were marked by much laughter and discussion. Students felt more confident about finding employment and using videos and podcasts during their degree programme, with many being encouraged to start their own.


